## Worthington Christian School Attendance Policies

Please make sure you are familiar with our attendance policies when planning absences. Below is a brief summary of our policies regarding academic integrity and regulated attendance rules. More details can be found in our student handbook.

## **Academic Integrity** – Maintaining class credits

- After **14 class period** absences in a semester, a student's class credit may be in jeopardy. Excused and unexcused absences both count towards the 14 class period absences.
- Any student absent from a ½ credit/l semester class for any reason for **14** days, may not receive credit for that class.
- Any student absent from a 1 credit/2 semester class for any reason for 28 days may not receive credit for that class.

**Regulated Attendance Rules** – We must keep with our <u>legal responsibilities</u> as a school chartered by the State of Ohio and accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International. *Students on the EdChoice Scholarship who do not abide by our attendance policy may be at risk of losing their scholarship.* 

- Students may not have more than 20 <u>unexcused</u> days during a single school year.
  - o **Unexcused** absences include vacations, weddings, traveling, etc.
- The only absences that can be marked as **"excused"** are the following. Please see our handbook regarding the documentation requirements for each type.
  - Illness or injury
  - Serious illness in the family
  - o Death of a relative
  - o Medical or dental appointment
  - College visit
  - o Emergency or other set of circumstances
  - o Out-of-state enrichment activities or extracurricular activities
    - Students can have up to 4 days per school year "excused" for these types of activities. Any additional days absent will be counted as "unexcused."
    - Enrichment activities include mission trips, conferences, etc.
    - Extracurricular activities include sports and music/arts activities.
