The Worthington Christian School Gifted Teacher will provide support to students identified as gifted attending WCS in grades 7 and 8. Coordinating with teachers and administration, the Gifted Teacher will implement effective strategies and practices to enhance identified student's academic experience.

Professional Responsibilities (essential)

Student Records and Documentation

- Identify students in the gifted learning program through analysis of test scores and state recommendations
- Create Written Education Plans (WEPs) for all 7th and 8th grade students in the gifted learning program
- Monitor progress on WEP goals biannually and communicate results with families

Classroom Support

- Coordinate with classroom teachers to ensure that gifted learners are challenged through differentiated assignments and learning objectives
- Teach a 7th and 8th grade section of Gifted Extension, providing supplemental instruction and focused work on individual goals
- Provide support in the 7th and 8th grade English classrooms for gifted students through differentiation and small group instruction (15 class periods a week)

Other Responsibilities

- Coordinate the gifted learning program for grades 7 and 8 in conjunction with the office of teaching and learning
- Provide academic guidance for identified gifted students in grades 7-8 in conjunction with the guidance department
- Communicate with families on gifted learning, including in-school opportunities as well as out of school opportunities
- Plan for and execute a meaningful extension opportunity for students in grades 7 and 8 each quarter
- Conduct "learning/project fairs" open to the broader community where gifted students share their research and work with one another and guests outside WCS
- Coordinate opportunities for engagement with the broader community where gifted students experience real-world learning
- Develop internship and experiential learning opportunities for students in the gifted program

Professional Requirements

- Undergraduate degree in secondary or middle childhood education
- State licensure in at least one core discipline area (English preferred)
- Licensure in Gifted Education or an endorsement in Gifted Education
- Strong oral and written communication skills
- Proficiency in the Microsoft Office suite
- History of collaborative teaching (preferred)
- Experience with project-based learning (preferred)
- Experience in multiple disciplines (preferred)
